Location:

Timber-lee Christian Center, located in southern Wisconsin near the southernmost end of the picturesque Kettle Moraine State Forest, encompasses 650 acres of wooded, rolling, scenic land. The camp is easily accessible 45 minutes southwest of Milwaukee, 1 hour east of Madison, 2 hours northwest of Chicago and 1 hour northeast of Rockford. Since it opened on this site in May 1972, Timber-lee has established itself as one of the premier Christian Camping programs in the Midwest.

Accommodations:

Timber-lee has a year round bed capacity of 388! Our dorm style cabins can accommodate groups of almost any size. You will be greeted and delighted by warm, carpeted, comfortable accommodations. All cabins are equipped with bunk beds, heat, and bathrooms. Beds are equipped with a fitted sheet, pillow, and pillowcase. **A sleeping bag and towels are all that are necessary to bring.**

Meeting Areas:

A meeting room is provided on a complimentary basis, if available, to groups staying overnight at Timber-lee. We have a wide variety of meeting rooms and styles accommodating from 20 to 350 people. Some are located in your lodge while all others are in close proximity to your housing. In addition, all meeting rooms are equipped with necessary audio-visual equipment.

Dining:

Delicious buffet-style meals are available at the Redwood Commons for scheduled groups. Your group will be able to eat together in one of our 4 dining halls.
